The Greenbushes Discovery Centre is looking for some new volunteers to help out with opening the centre.



#### FIRE SAFETY FOR WINTER

More than 1,000 fires occur in homes each winter in Australia and most are caused by fires, heaters or cooking appliances.

There are some basic tips than can help keep you safe in your home this winter.

- · keep all items at least 1 metre from fires
- Never leave heaters on in rooms especially in children's rooms.
- Never leave cooking appliances unattended
- Switch off all appliances after use
- Don't hang teatowels near cooking appliances.

Having a working smoke alarm will increase your chances of getting out of your home safely in the event of a fire. Check your alarm regularly and replace the batteries.

# Blackwood Basin Group Update



The Priority Bittern and Waterbird Biodiversity Enhancement Project, coordinated by the Blackwood Basin Group (BBG), has continued to make progress with lots of action at the site. The four year project, funded by the Australian Government, aims to create a wetland haven at Schwenke's Dam, Greenbushes, to attract critically endangered waterbirds.

#### Wildlife workshop

The BBG's wildlife handling, safety, transport, and first aid course was a great success.

A greatly experienced veterinary nurse and wildlife rehabilitator, Jo Burston from Maroo Wildlife Refuge, gave the 30 participants a real insight into the world of animal handling and how to respond to injured wildlife.

Gloves, towels, pillow slips, and hessian bags are the tools of the trade along with an attitude that can understand the animal's perspective. The group were very appreciative when Greg Kennedy from Talison Lithium gave a pair of gloves to each attendee, thank you Greg!

#### Revegetation

Aboriginal group NEEDAC and the Bridgetown Camp School recently planted 1200 seedlings between them at Waterbird Project sites. These seedling will grow to become ideal habitat for Ringtail Possums that have been spotted in the area. "Both groups thoroughly enjoyed planting wetland species and learning how their efforts will benefit native wildlife" says BBG Project Officer Joby Rand.

#### Feral animal control

A 1080 baiting program targeting foxes at Schwenke's Dam and on the active mine site is near completion with any remaining baits being collected at the beginning of August. Foxes are a major threat to native fauna species and ongoing control of these pests will enable native wildlife to increase in numbers. A trapping program will also be conducted in August to control pests who did not take baits.

#### Wetland invertebrates

The BBG recently purchased some custom made storage and display cases for the volunteer collected wetland invertebrate collection. These cases, made from recycled timber, allow the volunteers to cross reference new specimens with ones already identified and speeds up the processing of samples.


#### Daviesia decurrens: Prickly Bitter Pea
