Community investment

As Talison continues expanding its operations to keep up with demand for the global transition to cleaner energy, so too will the benefits that flow into surrounding communities. Each year Talison proudly supports local initiatives that positively impact these communities.

The Talison Community Investment Program (CIP) is designed to offer substantial funding opportunities for strategic programs and projects, which drive the development of social capital and local ownership. It engages a diverse range of stakeholders, including but not limited to incorporated not-for-profit community groups, local government, and education and training providers.

The four pillars of Talison's CIP are:

Quality Education

Sustainable Environments and Biodiversity Improvement

Health and Wellbeing; and

Vibrant and Sustaining communities.

Projects funded through inaugural 2023 round of the CIP include:

- \$3M to the Shire of Donnybrook Balingup for redevelopment of recreation facilities at Donnybrook's VC Mitchell Park
- \$1.64M to support the Shire of Bridgetown-Greenbushes capital works program
- \$0.20M to fund the civil works to support an expansion of Geegeelup Village in Bridgetown;
- \$0.19M to fund a refurbishment of the Greenbushes RSL Hall in Greenbushes.

The Talison Community Sponsorship and Donations Program is another funding initiative that provides support to smaller-scale community projects. In 2023, Talison allocated more than \$170,000 in donations and \$198,000 in-kind support to 82+ community groups through the Community Sponsorship and Donations Program.

The Reverend Fighting 'Mac' McKenzie

William McKenzie (1869-1947), a Salvation Army officer and military chaplain, was born on 20 December 1869 at Lanarkshire, Scotland, In 1884, when fourteen years of age, his family migrated to Queensland and settled near

Bundaberg, where his father had purchased

a sugar-cane farm.

In 1887, William McKenzie became a devout Christian, and in January 1890 he received his first appointment as a Salvation Army Lieutenant. On 21 June 1899, William married fellow Salvation Army Officer Annie Hoepper in Horsham, Victoria. By 1911, William and Annie had four children and lived in Bendigo where William was a Salvation Army Brigadier.

At the outbreak of the First World War. William McKenzie was appointed as a chaplain with the Australian Expeditionary Force. On 19 October 1914, as chaplain attached to the 4th Australian Infantry Battalion he embarked for Alexandria. On 25 April 1915 McKenzie arrived at Gallipoli with the first troops.

McKenzie was one of the first chaplains ashore at Gallipoli; he lumped stretchers and carried water for months on end as well as tending the wounded and burying the dead. McKenzie was with the 4th Battalion

during the Battle of Lone Pine in early August 1915. McKenzie who was soon to become famous as 'Fighting Mac', lost 32 kg at Gallipoli.

'Fighting Mac' soon became renowned as a soldier as well as a chaplain. Reports abound that he led charges at Gallipoli, often armed only with a shovel.

The men often pleaded with him to stay behind, but he replied, 'Boys, I have lived with you, I've preached to you and I've prayed with you. Do you think I'm afraid to die with you?'

Stories of McKenzie's fighting exploits may well have been exaggerat-

chaplains were prevented from joining in the fight due to their position.





After Gallipoli, McKenzie travelled to the Western Front and was present at the battles of Pozières, Bullecourt, Mouquet Farm, Polygon Wood, Passchendaele, and the Somme.



During the war McKenzie was mentioned in despatches, awarded a Military Cross and rumoured to have been recommended three times for the Victoria Cross.

On return to Australia in March 1918, Fighting Mac was given a tremendous welcome home. Great public gatherings were held in each state and a crowd of around 7000 greeted him at the Melbourne Exhibition Building. After his return, he continued to suffer from nightmares and memory loss. The horrors of war had profoundly affected him and taken its toll. He once said he was 'completely unstrung and unnerved. I had seen so many fine chaps killed ... I had buried so many, that I had to ask myself again and again, is it worthwhile living?' William McKenzie was appointed O.B.E. in 1935.

On 1 March 1939 McKenzie retired from active work and was farewelled quietly in accordance with his wish. His struggle with long illnesses ended on 27 July 1947. He died at the age of 77 and was buried in Rookwood Cemetery, Sydney. He was survived by his wife, three sons and daughter.
