The setting was beautiful and the weather was perfect for the Blackwood Basin Group's Fishing Competition at the Greenbushes Pool on Saturday 24th October.

The competition attracted considerable attention with keen fishers setting up positions around the pool and boardwalk and others coming down to watch the event.

The target was the pesky feral Redfin Perch which has infiltrated the waterways in the South-West.

Blackwood Basin Group Project Officer, Joby Rand, said the purpose of the competition was two-fold-to encourage people to enjoy the great outdoors on the waterways in Greenbushes and to help eradicate the feral Redfin Perch from them.

Many people obtained new fishing licences, especially for the event and the BBG are hoping those people will continue to fish for the Redfin Perch. It will take considerable fishing to control the proliferation of the Redfin Perch.





AUSTRALIA POST GRANT SUCCESS





The RSL members, in particular, Ray Mills and Barry Boyle, used the opportunity to clean out the shed and refurbish some of the equipment which was then sold on the day.


The RSL raised \$880 which will go towards refurbishment of the amenities and undercover area.


Thank You to the Shire

Blackwood Basin Group Update



The Priority Bittern and Waterbird Biodiversity Enhancement Project, coordinated by the Blackwood Basin Group (BBG), has continued to make progress with lots of action at the site. The four year project, funded by the Australian Government, aims to create a wetland haven at Schwenke's Dam, Greenbushes, to attract critically endangered waterbirds.

Redfin fishing competition

A fun, family friendly atmosphere enveloped the Redfin fishing competition. Entrants came from far and wide including Busselton and Margaret River to catch these pests that do so much damage to native aquatic fauna.

The event has tremendous potential to impact pest fish numbers and future events could focus on the Greenbushes area or spread throughout the SW.

In total, 16 people entered and 7 Redfin were caught, so the fish weren't exactly biting on the day. A number of people paid for licences specifically for the event and we are sure to see these people heading out to the waterways of the SW to catch even more pest fish.




Photo competition

The students are learning about changing land use in the mining industry are were eager to see this in person. The students got the chance to learn about the BBG's work in the area and participated in two hands on activities.

One group collected and identified macro-invertebrates that can indicate water quality while the other group monitored revegetation success and spread fertiliser tablets to promote plant growth.



Thank you to Erica from Bridgetown and Kathy and Larry from Balingup Donnybrook who provided valuable information which may just save a life.


RABBITS ON THE RISE - BOOSTING BIOLOGICAL CONTROL

Rabbit populations are on the rise and so are requests for control advice.

A naturally occurring variant of the Calicivirus, found in Korea (called RHDV K5) has been identified for release in Australia. This variant is expected to be more effective in cool, wet regions as it overcomes a benign calicivirus strain which protects rabbits from the virulent strain.

The RHDV K5 release is still pending approval however it is expected it will be available for release in August 2016-17. Land owners are encouraged to register their interest in becoming an RHDV K5 release site. Call 1800 084 881 to find out more. MLC BARRY HOUSE TO RETIRE


Member for South West, the Hon Barry House has announced he will retire at the end of the current Parliamentary term.


