GREENBUSHES RECEIVES STATE TIDY TOWNS AWARD

Greenbushes has won the West Australian Tidy Towns Award for Natural Environment Conservation.

The presentation was made at the Tidy Towns Awards in Perth in September where the town was recognised for its commitment to improving the natural environment.

The judges were impressed with the town's Waterbird Project which is a partnership between the Blackwood Basin Group, Talison Lithium, Department of Parks and Wildlife, Greenbushes Community Garden and other community groups.

The project, to create a waterbird wetland on an historic mining void has attracted Federal Government Funding over four years which is being administered by the

Blackwood Basin Group. The BBG has established an office at the Greenbushes Community Garden and has harnessed a team of local volunteers to be a part of the project. Nearly 1,000 hours were contributed to the project by volunteers over a 12 month period including planting workshops, dam modifications, water quality and macro-invertebrate monitoring, weed mapping, weed control and flora and fauna monitoring.

The award also recognised the work of the Greenbushes Community Garden Group for contributing to the town's environmental outcomes through education on frogs, bees and bugs.

There were 56 contenders for the Natural Environment Category in the State Awards. Greenbushes Tidy Towns Group has received \$1,500 prize money.






NATURE PLAY PASSPORT FOR LOCAL CHILDREN




Photo competition

JUNGLE ANIMALS OUT TO PLAY AT GREENBUSHES PRIMARY SCHOOL


