HANDY TIP:

Connecting SatBox to TV

There are a few ways of doing this.

i. Connect an HDMI cable from the SatBox HDMI to an HDMI input on your TV. (Best quality and recommended).

ii: Connect the Component Cable (Green, Blue & Red) from SatBox to TV Component input.

Connect a Red and white audio cable between the Red and White connectors on the SatBox and the Audio In connectors on your TV. (Good quality, but lots of cables).

iii. Connect normal (Composite) video cable to Yellow connector on SatBox to the Composite Video in connector on your TV. (Acceptable but not optimum quality).

Connecting DVD recorder to system.

We recommend the following setup.

a. Connect SatBox via HDMI as per Method i. above. (Connect to HDMI 1 on TV)

b. Connect DVD Recorder outputs to TV (Ideally via HDMI out of DVD Recorder to another HDMI input on TV, Say input 2.

c. Connect Normal Video (Composite) yellow connector from SatBox to Video Input on DVD recorder.

Connect SatBox Audio out to DVD Recorder audio in on the same input you connected the video in.

By selecting HDMI input 2 on TV and the VIDEO IN on DVD Recorder you should see the output of the SatBox.
